Grants will range from \$500 to \$1000 per year, depending on funds available.

Grant Requirements:

- ❖ Recipient must be a registered Republican voter in Walton County, Florida.**
- ❖ Recipient must have a high school diploma or GED.**
- ❖ Recipient must be enrolled, or have immediate plans to enroll, in the school or program of choice.**
- ❖ Grant funds will be sent to the school or program of choice and made available in January 2018 through the Financial Aid Department.**

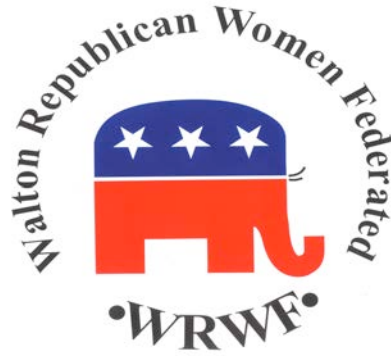
